

IS ALL CHANGE GOOD?

Many times people get caught up in movements of Change. Some change is honorable and some is necessary. However, the Bible teaches us that not all Change is good.

- Nadab and Abihu made a CHANGE to the command of God in regards to worship and offered an unauthorized sacrifice. “And there went out fire from the LORD, and devoured them, and they died before the LORD” (Lev. 10:2).
- Jeroboam changed the authorized place for worship, the authorized priests for worship, and the authorized sacrifice for worship (1 Kin. 12:29-33). God said this CHANGE was a sin (1 Kin. 12:30) and in so doing, Jeroboam “made Israel to sin” (2 Kin. 10:29) as well.
- God says homosexuals, “CHANGE the natural use [*of the body*] into that which is against nature...working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompense of their error which was meet” (Rom. 1:26-27, emphasis mine).
- Those who worship false gods and false doctrines have, “CHANGED the truth of God into a lie” (Rom. 1:25, emphasis mine).
- False teachers and deceitful workers CHANGE into “sheep’s clothing,” (Mat. 7:15) and disguise themselves to be “apostles of Christ” (2 Cor. 11:13).
- Satan can CHANGE into a disguise and deceive people into believing he is “an angel of light” (2 Cor. 11:14).

Let us be cautious and vigilant in all aspects of life (1 Pet. 5:8).
