## THE 2016 PROPHECY: THE GLOBAL WARMING HOAX

On Friday, November 13, the movie, 2012, hit the theaters. According to the movie's official website, "2012 is an epic adventure about a global cataclysm that brings an end to the world and tells of the heroic struggle of the survivors." The movie is a fictional tale devised in the minds of creative writers. The date, 2012, finds its origin in the "Long Count" calendar created by the ancient Mayans. The Mayans calculated that the universe is created and destroyed every 5,125 years (or so). Their belief that the universe as we know it began in 3114 B.C. insists that the end of the universe will occur in 2012 A.D. The Mayans were a corrupt, polytheistic, human-sacrificing "civilization." The temperature trend for the period of record (1895 to present) is 0.0 degrees Fahrenheit per decade" (ncdc.noaa.gov/oa/climate/research/cag3/na.html). How then is global warming being reported as fact in the media and among some in the highest offices of our government? It is promoted the same way as is the ungodly error of Darwinian evolution. Spontaneous generation (non-life producing life) and the idea that one species can turn into another have both been proven to be impossible.
