

The Knox County Church of Christ is made up of individuals who heard God's Word (Romans 10:17), believed it (John 8:24), repented of past sins (Acts 2:38), confessed that Jesus is the Christ (Romans 10:9-10), and were baptized, or immersed into water, in order to have their sins washed away (Acts 22:16).
