

"GOSPEL MEETING CHECK-LIST"

Beginning Sunday, May 20th, we will be hosting a Gospel Meeting with guest speaker, Terry York, an elder and preacher with the Northside Church of Christ in Calhoun, GA. Brother York is a good man who loves the souls of men and has worked hard in preparation for our Gospel Meeting. We look forward to having him, his wife, Yvonne, and their daughter, Emilie, with us next week.

With just one more week to prepare for this evangelistic effort, let us not now begin to relax. Let us double (or triple) our efforts during this last week – “redeeming the time, because the days are evil” (Eph. 5:16). Our Gospel Meeting is an opportunity to strengthen our faith (Acts 20:32), “renew” those who have fallen away (Heb. 6:6), and to seek and save those who are lost (Luke 19:10). We have been given a great commission – “Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world” (Mat. 28:19-20).
