

From The Preacher's Pen "LOYALTY TO CHRIST"

The word, *Loyalty*, is not found in the Bible, yet the principle of loyalty is found from cover to cover in the Scriptures. To be loyal means that one has true allegiance to a constituted authority and is faithful in commitment. Loyalty implies trust and confidence in the supreme authority.

Loyalty, faithfulness, is a part of our lives in so many ways. We should be loyal, faithful, to our promises. The government demands loyalty. It is required in labor unions, political parties, and the military. We want our police to be loyal to the law. Loyalty is essential, demanded in the Christian life. Jesus said, "Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life" (Rev. 2:10).

What does loyalty to Christ include? It demands that we are true to God's Word. It is written, "Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on Him, If ye continue in My Word, *then* are ye My disciples indeed" (John 8:31). One can only be faithful to Jesus as long as he is abiding in the doctrine of Christ. Loyalty to Christ demands personal commitment to Him. It means putting Jesus above self – "Then said Jesus unto His disciples, If any *man* will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me" (Mat. 16:24). Pleasure, comfort, and personal safety must be secondary at all times. We must put Jesus first if we want to save our soul.

Sadly, decisions are made every day to whom or what we place our trust and loyalty and it is not Christ Jesus who comes out on top in our hearts. In religion, many times people pledge their loyalty to a creed, religious school, denomination, a preacher, and even honor their best friends above loyalty to Jesus. Truly, friends are of great treasure and must be treated as precious, yet we must never let friendship or anyone or anything keep us from the Lord.

The rewards of loyalty to Christ are great. He has promised His faithful a home with Him in Heaven. It is written: "Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: if *it were* not *so*, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, *there* ye may be also" (John 14:1-3).
