

Paul tells us of people who measure themselves by themselves (2 Cor. 10:12). They did not compare themselves with the word of God nor the Apostles. They compared themselves with each other. Sometimes we do the same thing and we hear others say, "I am as good as he is". That may be true, and both of us may be far from the true standard. What does it mean to be free? John Winthrop said, "There is a double liberty". It is true that we have a double liberty. The dope addict and sex pervert says he is free from Christ but a slave to sin. "While they promise Liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage" (II Pet. 2:19). Freedom from Christ is the Liberty exercised by the beast of the field. It is liberty to be evil. In this Liberty man grows more evil and often becomes worse than the animals of the forest.
